### **WHAT:**

The West Texas Dig Fest grass volleyball tournament in Abilene, Texas  
April 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>, The ROC Fields—1042 Loop 322, Abilene, TX 79602

### **Pre-Event Check-In:**

It is mandatory that a representative from each team must check-in at the tournament headquarters tent between 8:00-8:30am on Saturday/Sunday morning to receive any important information or changes about their pools.

### **Dig Fest Division Information:**

Coed Divisions: Triples

These divisions are for adult and junior level players. There must be at least one female player in the game at all times. Roster size cannot be more than 4 players.

Men's/Women's: Triples

Adult players 18 years or older. Roster size cannot be more than 4 players.

Adults can register for both days of competition.

### **Division Levels:**

AA/A:

This level is for advanced players who have consistent control of skills. They attack very hard, pass and set well and may have great jump serves.

Entry fee: \$40 per player

BB:

This level is for intermediate players. Competes well but does not have consistent crushing power. Not necessarily a tall player but has decent skill.

Entry fee: \$40 per player

B:

This level is for more beginners and recreational players. Skills such as passing, setting, and attacking are pretty inconsistent. No jump serving, only standing serves are allowed.

Entry fee: \$40 per player

## **Which Division Should I Choose?**

It is very important to pick the correct division for your group. The player with the highest level of skill will determine the team's correct level of play. If you have a team member that has high skill levels; can pass well, can jump serve, etc. then your entire team should be in the A/AA division.

## **No Sandbagging!!**

This is when a team obviously has allowed at least one team member to play that is above the average of the other players in that division level. Sandbagging is not allowed, and such teams could be ejected from the tournament.

## **Expectations of Dig Fest Participants:**

This event is specifically designed to offer a fun weekend of volleyball for all age groups and ability levels. Poor conduct, such as unnecessary language, repeated arguing about calls, and sandbagging will result in a team or player being ejected from the tournament. Any complaints regarding poor conduct from players or teams should be reported to the tournament headquarters tent.

## **Prizes:**

Winners of each division will be awarded with merch and other prizes from local business sponsors.
